FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

MCMCF is committed to educating staff, residents and visitors on the Facility's Emergency Preparedness Procedures. Recent natural disasters have made it clear that long term care facilities are not exempt from experiencing flooding, loss of power and water and damage from winds, falling trees, etc.

Here in the UP, we are fortunate to not have to worry about hurricanes, tsunamis, earthquakes and flash floods that are common in some parts of the United States. We do, however, have to be prepared for wildfires, severe weather (snowstorms and wind storms) and even man-made disasters, such as a collision on US 41 involving a semi-truck hauling hazardous materials, that could release a cloud of toxic gas that could drift over the facility.

To prepare for natural and man-made emergencies that could impact residents, staff and family members, MCMCF has developed an **Emergency Preparedness Plan** that addresses how staff should react in the event of a fire, severe weather, bomb threat, hostile intruder, loss of power, hazardous material releases, etc. A copy of this plan is located by the door to the front office as well as at nurse's stations throughout the facility. I encourage all resident family members to take a few minutes to review this plan and become familiar with how their loved ones will be protected in the event of a disaster.

As recent events have shown, the better prepared we are going into a disaster, the better we will be at coming out of the disaster with few, or any, losses.

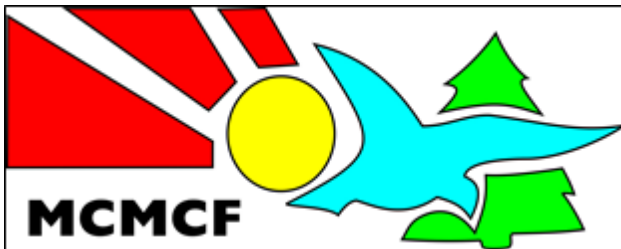
