Reminders for approaching our pets

The opportunity to interact with an animal can have a very positive impact upon a resident's quality of life. It can change behavior and significantly impact the treatment of conditions like agitation, depression, loneliness and overall functioning. It has been proven that pets can help to reduce blood pressure and stress levels as well. We are proud to offer pet interactions in our facility. Unfortunately, our pets are animals. Even the best trained pet can bite under certain circumstances.

When approaching a pet please remember:

1. Some pets can become aggressive with strangers and children. Sometimes, they can be protective of their humans. Approach pets on others laps slowly and pay attention to warnings (growling, hissing, etc.).
2. Greet the pet with your arm out in front of you and your hand palm down.
3. Hold your hand low so the pet can smell it. If it turns away, leave it be. If it leans in or licks your hand, you've been given the green light, but proceed slowly.
4. Pet them gently, paying attention to their response.
5. Do not approach face to face. The best way to approach a pet is to keep your side towards them so they will not feel threatened and uncomfortable.
6. Do not move your fist towards them or hover over them. Do not make threatening or fast moves. Instead, act calmly. Dogs are usually very territorial, and do not really want their personal space invaded.
7. Avoid shouting or making noises that could possibly startle the pet. Let them approach you first.
